Read and Discuss

Read the Psalm together out loud. Have one person read v 1-5, and another read 6-9. Read verses 10-13 together. The group leader can close by reading verses 14-19.

Discuss:

V1 – in what is David hoping?

What does the Psalm teach about God's character?

What does the Psalm teach about us – humankind?

What does God want to do?

What will David do after experiencing God's cleansing power?

Sometimes we have made the mistake of assuming that the Old Testament is all about law and sacrifice – external things rather than the heart and a personal knowledge of God. Read v. 17 aloud then go to Romans 12 and read verses 1 and 2.
